ARC Resources Ltd. ("ARC") seeks a right of entry order to access the Lands legally owned by Rebecca Kathleen Louise Ingram (formerly Dekock) to construct and operate three flowlines.

On December 16, 2022 I conducted a mediation conference via Zoom attended by myself; Blaine Ham from ARC; Rick Williams, counsel for ARC; Reba Ingram, the Respondent landowner; and Pamela Boles, counsel for Ms. Ingram.

The parties discussed various concerns with the right of entry. I am satisfied that ARC requires entry to the Lands for an approved oil and gas activity, namely constructing and operating flowlines as approved in the Oil and Gas Commission's Application Determination Number 100113608.

The Surface Rights Board orders:

ORDER

- 1. Upon payment of the amounts set out in paragraphs 2 and 3, ARC shall have the right of entry to and access across the portion of the Lands shown outlined in red on the Individual Ownership Plan attached as Appendix "A", on the Terms and Conditions set out at Appendix "B", for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining the flowlines and associated infrastructure as permitted by the Oil and Gas Commission by Application Determination Number 100113608.
- 2. ARC shall pay to the landowner as partial compensation the amount of \$500.
- 3. ARC shall deliver to the Surface Rights Board security in the amount of \$2,500 by cheque made payable to the Minister of Finance. All or part of the security deposit may be returned to ARC, or paid to the landowner, upon agreement of the parties or as ordered by the Board.
- 4. Nothing in this order operates as a consent, permission, approval, or authorization of matters within the jurisdiction of the Oil and Gas Commission.


