Vermilion Energy Inc. ("Vermilion") seeks a right of entry order to access certain lands legally owned by Roy Ralph Juell to carry out an approved energy resource activity, namely the construction, operation, maintenance and drilling of a multiwell padsite, natural gas wells and associated infrastructure.

The parties consent to the following order:

ORDER

- 1. Upon payment of the amount set out in paragraph 2, Vermilion shall have the right of entry to and access across the portions of the lands shown outlined in red on the Individual Ownership Plan attached as Appendix "A" (the "Lands") as necessary for the purpose of drilling, constructing, operating and maintaining a multi-well padsite, natural gas wells and associated infrastructure in accordance with BCER Permit No. 100118466.
- 2. Vermilion shall pay to the landowner as initial compensation the total amount of \$54,625.00.
- 3. Vermilion shall pay annual rent, commencing on the first anniversary of the date of this order, in the total amount of \$12,517.70
- 4. Upon the drilling of any additional wells, Vermilion shall pay to the landowner \$2,000 as initial compensation and increase the annual rent by \$500, for each additional well drilled. Such amounts to not be paid until such time as Vermilion drills the well(s).
