WHEREAS Westgrowth Petroleums Ltd. ("Westgrowth") applied December 5, 1979 for an Order of the Commission declaring the British Columbia Petroleum Corporation ("B.C.P.C.") a common purchaser of natural gas from the Buick Creek North Dunlevy A Pool; and

WHEREAS Westgrowth owns one well in the Rigel

Area which tested gas from the Dunlevy formation, namely:

Westgrowth et al Buick C-52-C/94-A-14; and

WHEREAS Westgrowth alleges that it is suffering drainage of raw gas in the Buick Creek North Dunlevy A Pool.
