ORDER

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 63(a) of the Act the Commission may require every energy utility of the same class to adopt a prescribed uniform system of accounting; and

WHEREAS the Commission has prepared a Uniform System of Accounts for Electric Utilities, dated May, 1980, a copy of which is available from the Commission and which it considers appropriate to prescribe for implementation.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders that the aforementioned Uniform System of Accounts for Electric Utilities be prescribed for adoption as from January 1, 1981, by all energy utilities providing electric utility service to the public or any corporation for compensation.
