CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

WHEREAS Edaltho Enterprises Ltd. applied during
1980 for the issuance by the British Columbia Utilities
Commission of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity
to permit the operation of an electrical utility service; and

WHEREAS Edaltho Enterprises Ltd. owns and operates
a diesel generating plant and distribution facilities in place
and has been supplying electricity to Gateway Lodge located in
the Eastgate area of Manning Park; and

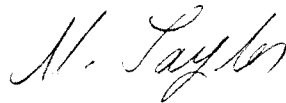
WHEREAS the Commission has considered the
Application of Edaltho Enterprises Ltd. and believes that
electrical utility service it affords is necessary for the
public convenience and properly conserves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby:

1. Grants to Edalthe Enterprises Ltd. a Certificate under Section 51(6) of the Act authorizing the operation of the electrical utility service on an interim basis, commencing November 1, 1980 for the supply of electricity to Gateway Lodge.
2. Subject to further Order of the Commission, the Certificate referred to herein will be cancelled and revoked when permanent transmission and distribution facilities are constructed.
