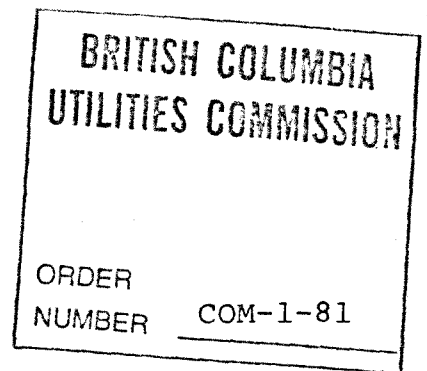

WHEREAS Wintershall Oil of Canada Ltd.
("Wintershall") applied November 28, 1980 for an Order of the
Commission declaring the British Columbia Petroleum Corpora-
tion ("B.C.P.C.") a common purchaser of natural gas from the
Dahl Bluesky Pool; and

WHEREAS Wintershall owns a well in the Dahl Area
which tested gas from the Bluesky formation, namely:

Wincan et al Dahl c-98-A, 94-H-10; and

WHEREAS Wintershall alleges that it is suffering
drainage of raw gas in the Dahl Bluesky Pool.
