O R D E R

WHEREAS by Order G - 75 - 81, dated October 7, 1981
the Commission ordered, in Paragraph numbered 5 as follows:

"Argument will be the subject of a separate
and final phase of the Hearing. Those
parties wishing to make their argument
at the end of a particular phase or at
the conclusion of the special hearing in
Vancouver may do so without prejudice to
their right to make argument in the Argument
Phase but the parties are urged to avoid
repetition of argument".

AND WHEREAS it now appears to the Commission that
the hearing processes and the interests of all parties would be better
served by hearing argument on all phases after all the evidence is in.

NOW THEREFORE The Commission Orders that:

1. Paragraph numbered 5 in Order G- 75 - 81 is
hereby revoked.
2. Argument will be the subject of a separate and
final phase of the hearing.
