O R D E R

WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor in Council
issued Order-in-Council No. 193 February 1, 1982 and direc-
ted the Commission to hold hearings on any Applications re-
ceived for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity
for the construction or operation of a pay-television under-
taking; and

WHEREAS the Commission issued a public notice
advising of the terms of reference of Order-in-Council
No. 193; and

WHEREAS Frank Ogden applied for a Certificate
of Public Convenience and Necessity by an Application dated
July 5, 1982; and

WHEREAS the Application was heard by the Commis-
sion in Vancouver on August 17, 1982.

ORDER

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NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

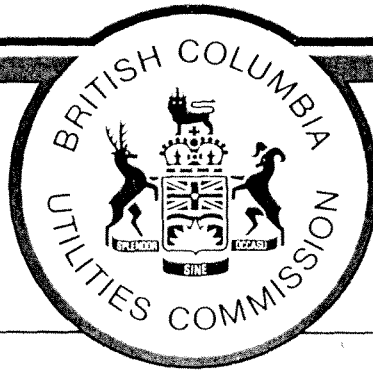
1. Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. T-2-82 issue to Frank Ogden covering the ownership and operation of a pay-television undertaking in the Province of British Columbia, all as more particularly described in the Application and hearing record, subject to the following condition:
 - (a) The service offered by the undertaking must be provided at the rates and under the terms of service described in the Application and the hearing record.
2. A complaint which the Commission finds is related to a matter which may be in contravention of the guidelines for enforcement of the obscenity provisions, Criminal Code of Canada may be referred to the Attorney General for investigation and the Commission may suspend the Certificate until such matter is concluded.
3. No variation or alteration in the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity or this Order may be made without the approval of the Commission first obtained.
