## ORDER

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Nelson ("City of Nelson") applied January 17, 1986 to amend its filed Electrical Utility Regulatory By-Law No. 2020, 1983 as amended by By-Law No. 2153, 1985 applicable to electric service rendered by City of Nelson in its service area; and

WHEREAS the amendments specified in Utility Regulatory Amendment By-Law No. 2160, 1986 are to permit the City of Nelson to delete existing Rate Schedules C-5 and C-6, replacing them with new Rate Schedules C-5 and C-6 designed to provide a reduced rate to industry with loads of 1,000 KVA or over; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application the purpose of which is to encourage the location of industry in the service area of Nelson, B.C., and supporting material, and finds that the filing of the amendments to the filed tariffs is appropriate and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders The Corporation of the City of Nelson as follows:

1. The Commission accepts for filing effective the date of this Order, Utility Regulatory Amendment By-Law No. 2160, 1986.
