O R D E R

WHEREAS on October 2, 1987 B.C. Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") applied pursuant to Section 67(2) of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act") for Commission approval of amendments to Electric Tariff Rate Schedules 1105 (Residential Dual Fuel Interruptible Service) and 1205 (General Dual Fuel Interruptible Service - Small Commercial), and the introduction of New Tariff Rate Schedules 1206 (General Dual Fuel Interruptible Service - Large Commercial) and 1207 (General Dual Fuel Interruptible Service - Industrial); and

WHEREAS B.C. Hydro states that the principal reason for the filing is to introduce amendments which will permit the extension of low-cost interruptible electric heating rates to customers with wood and coal fuel burning backup systems; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and is satisfied that it is appropriate and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission approves the October 2, 1987 Application and accepts for filing the following Electric Tariff Rate Schedules:

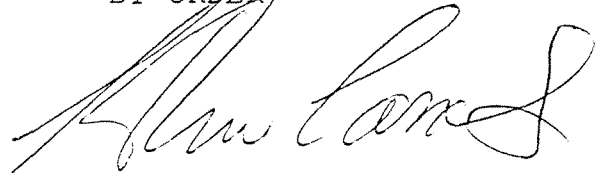
