## ORDER

WHEREAS Princeton Light & Power Company, Limited ("PLP") applied May 30, 1989 for Commission approval to firm-up rates effective January 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS Commission Order No. G-6-89 approved an interim increase in rates for PLP of 0.169¢/kW.h effective January 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS Commission Decision and Order No. G-24-89 confirmed, as firm, previously approved interim rates effective January I, 1989 for West Kootenay Power Ltd., PLP's power supplier; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that the confirmation and firming-up of the interim rates is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders PLP as follows:

> The Electric Tariff rates as filed with the Application dated May 30, 1989, which contain the previously approved interim increase of 0.169¢/kW.h, are confirmed as firm effective January 1, 1989.
