O R D E R

WHEREAS Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. ("PNG") filed on January 12, 1990 a Letter Agreement ("the Agreement") between PNG and Ocelot Chemicals Inc. ("Ocelot") dated December 8, 1989 covering Interruptible Transportation Service of $425 \times 10^3 \text{m}^3$ of gas to Ocelot's methanol/ammonia complex to April 30, 1990 at a transportation margin of \$6.1940 per 10^3m^3 ; and

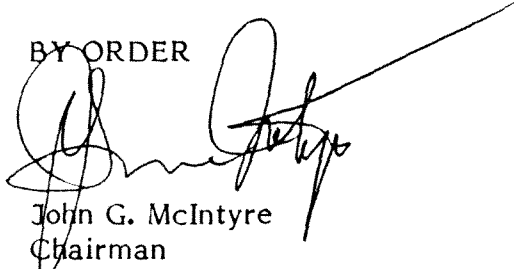
WHEREAS PNG received Commission approval by Order No. G-68-89 for Firm Transportation Service between PNG and British Columbia Petroleum Corporation/B.C. Petroleum (Kitimat) Ltd. by an Agreement dated December 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the Agreement and is satisfied that the filing properly conserves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission approves and accepts for filing the Letter Agreement dated December 8, 1989 between PNG and Ocelot effective to April 30, 1990 covering Interruptible Transportation Service of $425 \times 10^3 \text{m}^3$ of gas at a transportation margin of \$6.1940 per 10^3m^3 .
