## ORDER

WHEREAS Section 85.3 of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"), requires that Energy Supply Contracts ("Contracts") between producers and consumers, be filed with the Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS on August 18, 1988 the Commission issued Rules for the filing of such Contracts; and

WHEREAS Inland Natural Gas Marketing Ltd. ("INGM") has filed with the Commission draft natural gas supply contracts dated April 1, 1990 between FMC of Canada Limited ("FMC") and its suppliers, Petro-Canada Inc., and Canterra Energy Ltd., ("the Suppliers") for use in its hydrogen peroxide plant in Prince George, B.C., for the period commencing mid-April 1990 to October 31, 1990 inclusive under the Rules - Section 1.2.3; and

WHEREAS the Commission has reviewed the draft Contract and supporting material and is satisfied that it is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 85.3 of the Act the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves and accepts for filing the draft Energy Supply Contracts between FMC and the Suppliers which is designated as Energy Supply Contract, NGSC No. 17.
- 2. INGM is to file with the Commission a fully executed set of Energy Supply contracts on or before April 30, 1990.
