ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 24, 1991 Centra Gas British Columbia Inc. ("Centra Gas") applied to the Commission for approval to change its Commercial Sales Rebate in its Nanaimo District to a maximum rebate of \$1.50 per GJ; and
- B. Centra Gas requested the change in the Sales Rebate Program because the existing rate to Commercial Service Customers, after the rebate, could be lower than the competitive fuel price for a Range Rate Customer; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that approval is necessary and in the public interest.

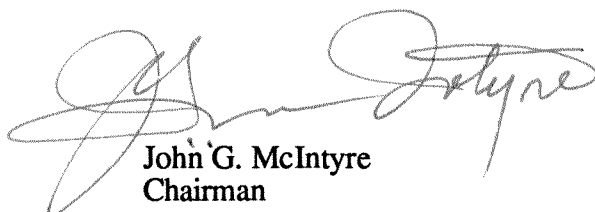
NOW THEREFORE the Commission hereby orders as follows:
