## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On April-29, 1991 Centra Gas Victoria Inc. ("Centra Gas") filed an application for Commission approval of amendments to its Gas Tariff Rate Schedules at Victoria, B.C., to allow for a pass-through of a decrease in propane product costs from its supplier; and
- B. The amendments provide for a rate decrease of \$1.731 per GJ to all customers effective with consumption on and after May 1, 1991; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and supporting material and is satisfied that the decreases are appropriate and in the public interest.

## NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves and accepts for filing, effective May 1, 1991, amendments to Centra Gas' Gas Tariff rate schedules as follows:

Second Revision Page 22 - Small General Service Rate Second Revision Page 23 - Large General Service Rate Second Revision Page 24 - Special Range Rate

- 2. An appropriate notice of explanation of the decrease in rates is to accompany all customer bills in the next regular monthly billing for Centra Gas customers.
- 3. Interest is to be charged or credited to Centra Gas' propane price deferral account at the rate of interest charged by its commercial lending bank.
