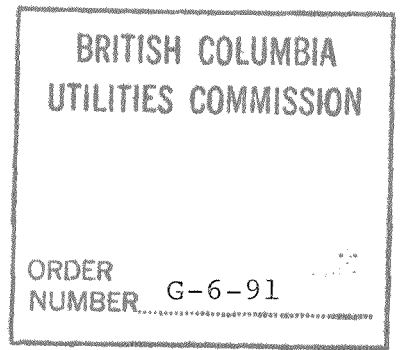

ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 4, 1991 ICG Utilities (British Columbia) Ltd. ("ICG") filed an application for Commission approval of amendments to its Gas Tariff Rate Schedules in the Nanaimo District to allow for a pass-through of increased propane product costs from its supplier; and
- B. The amendments provide for a rate increase of \$0.2789 per Ccf effective to all customers in the Nanaimo District effective with consumption on and after January 1, 1991; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and supporting material and is satisfied that the increases are appropriate and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves and accepts for filing, effective February 1, 1991, amendments to ICG's Gas Tariff rate schedules as follows:

Third Revision Page 37 - Residential Service Rate
Third Revision Page 38 - Commercial Service Rate
Third Revision Page 39 - Special Range Rate
2. An appropriate notice of explanation of the increase in rates is to accompany all customer bills in the next regular monthly billing for ICG customers.
