ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On January 4, 1991 Vancouver Island Gas Company ("Vigas") filed an application for Commission approval of amendments to its Gas Tariff Rate Schedules at Victoria, B.C., to allow for a pass-through of increased propane product costs from its supplier; and
- B. The amendments provide for a rate increase of \$2.2632 per GJ to all customers effective with consumption on and after January 1, 1991; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and supporting material and is satisfied that the increases are appropriate and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves and accepts for filing, effective February 1, 1991, amendments to Vigas' Gas Tariff rate schedules as follows:

First Revision Page 22 - Small General Service Rate First Revision Page 23 - Large General Service Rate First Revision Page 24 - Special Range Rate

2. An appropriate notice of explanation of the increase in rates is to accompany all customer bills in the next regular monthly billing for Vigas customers.
