## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On January 8, 1991 Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. ("PNG") filed an Application for Commission approval to accumulate in a deferral account, the changes to gas and commodity charges from its supplier, Westcoast Energy Inc.'s ("WEI") interim tolls, that may be made on a permanent basis, effective January 1, 1991.
- B. On December 27, 1990 the National Energy Board advised WEI that a final decision on its tolls would not be made prior to January 1, 1991 and authorized that interim tolls should remain in place, and issued Order No. TGI-5-90; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and is satisfied that the procedure of using a deferral account to account for interim WEI toll charge changes properly conserves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders PNG as follows:

The Commission approves for PNG the use of a deferral account to account for changes in WEI tolls, on an interim basis, effective with consumption on and after January 1, 1991
