O R D E R

WHEREAS:

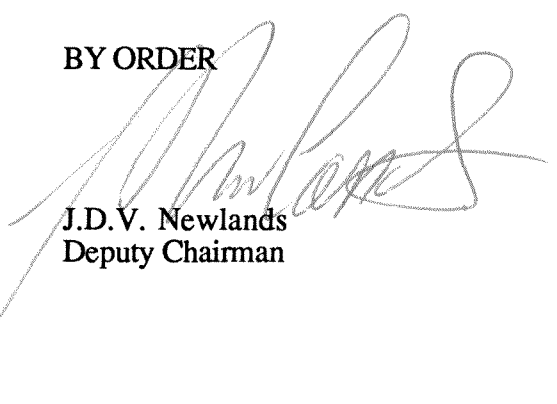
- A. On July 31, 1991 British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") applied to the Commission for approval of an Electric Service Agreement with Little Valley Forest Products Ltd. at Bella Coola Valley, B.C.; and
- B. The Agreement, known as Electric Tariff, Supplement No. 9, will allow B.C. Hydro to supply up to 500 kW of maximum demand at the 1991 rate of 11.8 cents per kW.h for an initial term of four years from July 24, 1991; and
- C. The energy rate charged under the Agreement will be subject to annual cost adjustments, based on the unit costs of the Ah-Sin-Heek diesel generating station; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the Agreement and finds that approval is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The June 28, 1991 Electric Service Agreement between B.C. Hydro and Little Valley Forest Products Ltd., known as Electric Tariff, Supplement No. 9, is approved and accepted for filing effective July 24, 1991.
