O R D E R

WHEREAS:

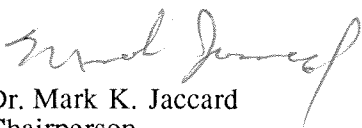
- A. On October 12, 1994 British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") applied to the Commission for approval of the supply of power in excess of 45 KVA to Stikine Regional Health Care Society ("the Society") at Dease Lake, B.C., by way of Special Contract allowed for in the Electric Tariff, Terms and Conditions in Rate Zone II, Page B-35; and
- B. The agreement, known as Electric Tariff Supplement No. 18, will allow B.C. Hydro to supply up to 225 kW of maximum demand for an initial term of two years from March 31, 1994. The Contract requires the customer to provide \$8,972 as a contribution toward the cost of the B.C. Hydro extension; and
- C. The 1994 energy rate of 12.30¢/kW.h charged under the Agreement will be subject to annual cost adjustments, based on the unit cost of power produced by B.C. Hydro diesel generators for supply to the Society; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the agreement and finds that approval is necessary and in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

The March 31, 1994 Special Contract between B.C. Hydro and Stikine Regional Health Care Society, known as Electric Tariff Supplement No. 18, is approved and accepted for filing effective March 31, 1994, for a period of two years, and month-to-month thereafter.
