## ORDER

## **WHEREAS:**

- A. On June 6, 1997 Princeton Light and Power Company, Limited ("PLP") applied for Commission approval to renew and amend its long-term debt credit agreement, pursuant to Section 50(2) of the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act"); and
- B. The June 3, 1997 credit arrangements with the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce ("CIBC") provide for the renewal of the fixed-term, fixed-rate ("FTFR") portion of the credit facilities in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for three years at an interest rate of 7.7 percent effective June 3, 1997; and
- C. The Commission has considered the application and supporting material and finds that approval of the loan restructuring with CIBC appropriate.

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to Section 50(2) of the Act, the Commission approves for PLP the FTFR credit facilities with CIBC in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 at an interest rate of 7.7 percent for 3 years effective June 3, 1997.
