O R D E R

WHEREAS:

- A. On February 24, 1998, Federated Pipe Lines (Western) Ltd. ("Federated") filed with the Commission an application to decrease tolls on its Taylor to Prince George and Taylor to Kamloops crude oil pipeline; and
- B. The 1998 tolls will be decreased by approximately \$0.02/m³ effective January 1, 1998 in accordance with the incentive tolling methodology that was agreed to by Federated and its shippers; and
- C. The Commission has considered the application and finds that approval is required.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 44 of the Pipeline Act, the Commission approves for Federated, Crude Petroleum Tariff No. 26 for tolls on its Taylor to Prince George and Taylor to Kamloops crude oil pipeline effective January 1, 1998. The approved toll is subject to review by the Commission following the receipt of a complaint from shippers on the pipeline.
- 2. Federated is to deliver a copy of this Order and Crude Petroleum Tariff No. 26 to all shippers on the pipeline.
