#### ORDER

#### WHEREAS:

- A. Commission Order No. G-123-98 approved the December 15, 1998 Settlement Agreement extending the rate adjustment mechanism ("the Incentive Mechanism") approved by Commission Order No. G-73-96 for the year ending December 31, 1999. Under this mechanism, West Kootenay Power Ltd. ("WKP") is required to file annually with the Commission materials for a rate increase effective January 1 of the next year; and
- B. The terms of the Settlement Agreement require that WKP file, by October 1999, a multi-year proposal to commence January 2000. The Application may propose a continuation of existing ratemaking methods but all parties reserve their right to argue in favour of proposed targets, performance based regulation methods or traditional rate regulation.
- C. The terms of the Settlement Agreement also require WKP to file, prior to November 7, 1999, Preliminary Revenue Requirement Materials, including a Statement of Adjustments for a rate increase effective January 1, 2000; and
- D. The Settlement Agreement included an Annual Review process, whereby the public will be invited to examine the filed material, submit other issues for determination by the Commission, and meet to review all issues. Following the review, unsatisfied parties may institute a complaint procedure before the Commission; and
- E. On September 3, 1999, WKP filed its Preliminary 2000-2002 Revenue Requirements and Incentive Mechanism Review ("the Proposal"). WKP applied pursuant to the Utilities Commission Act ("the Act") for an Order to set rates in accordance with the Incentive Mechanism during the period beginning January 1, 2000 and ending December 31, 2002; and
- F. WKP further applied for Orders approving certain costs and amendments to the Incentive Mechanism; and

G. WKP applied for an Order that a Negotiated Settlement Process be implemented with the following key dates:

- H. A 1999 Annual Review is required to assess WKP's performance and to make adjustments against 1998 and 1999 Revenue Requirements; and
- I. The Commission, in its desire to expedite issues relating to the Proposal, requires that a timetable and a process for dealing with the issues be established.

#### **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission will hold a Workshop on the Proposal on September 29 and 30, 1999, commencing at 10:00 a.m. at the Prestige Inn, 1675 Abbott Street, Kelowna, B.C., followed by a Pre-hearing Conference. The Conference will address procedural matters, which will include, but not be limited to, the following:
  - whether the WKP Preliminary 2000-2002 Revenue Requirements and Incentive Mechanism Review will proceed to a negotiated settlement process on November 15, 1999:
  - identification of principal issues;
  - changes to the Proposal; and
  - other matters that will enable the proceeding to efficiently cover and review all aspects of the Proposal.
- 2. The Commission will also hold a 1999 Annual Review on December 1, 1999 commencing at 9:00 a.m. at the same location. A Public Information Town Hall Meeting will commence at 7:00 p.m. on November 30, 1999 for those parties not wishing, or able, to participate in the 1999 Annual Review.
- 3. WKP will arrange for immediate publication, not later than September 17, 1999, in display-ad format, of a Notice of Workshop, Pre-hearing Conference and 1999 Annual Review, attached as Appendix A to this Order, in the appropriate local news publications in the service area of the Utility so as to provide adequate notice to the public.

At the Workshop, WKP will provide a detailed review of the Proposal, including the rationale for the Proposal and details of the cost and revenue forecasts.
