CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

WHEREAS:

- A. On March 23, 2000, West Kootenay Power Ltd. ("WKP") applied to the Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") for approval to upgrade its Powerhouse Crane at the South Slocan generating station which is located on the Kootenay River between Castlegar and Nelson, B.C.; and
- B. The project is estimated to cost \$430,000 and will upgrade the controls and motors of the existing crane. The project was designated an extraordinary capital project in WKP's approved 2000-2002 Revenue Requirements; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the costs, timing and justification for the Powerhouse Crane upgrade and finds that it should be approved.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 45 of the Act, a CPCN is granted to WKP to proceed with the Powerhouse Crane upgrade at the South Slocan generating station for a total estimated cost of \$430,000.
- 2. WKP is to file with the Commission a project report and cost summary on completion of the project.
