ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On December 21, 2000, British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("B.C. Hydro") applied to the Commission for approval, on a temporary basis until the next comprehensive rate design review, of Rate Schedule 1853 Transmission Service Station Service for Maintenance and Black-Start. On January 19, 2001, B.C. Hydro provided the Commission with a response to a staff information request; and
- B. The new service will allow Independent Power Producers ("IPPs") to obtain energy that is needed at their generation facilities during forced outages, scheduled maintenance requirements, and black-start reenergization of generators; and
- C. The rate to be charged by B.C. Hydro for Rate Schedule 1853 service will be a market based rate at the Dow Jones Mid-C Firm Electricity Price Index. The electricity is not available for replacement of electricity that would normally be generated by the IPP facilities; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that approval is required.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. The Commission approves for B.C. Hydro its December 21, 2000 application for Rate Schedule 1853 Transmission Service – Station Service for Maintenance and Black-Starts, effective January 25, 2001.

- 2. B.C. Hydro is to address Rate Schedule 1853 service in its next comprehensive rate design application at which time, following Commission approval, it will be replaced with a permanent rate schedule for this service.
- 3. B.C. Hydro is to provide all of its IPP customers with a copy of this Order and the approved Rate Schedule 1853, including the terms of service.
