## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On December 10, 2002, Centra Gas Whistler Inc. ("Centra Whistler") applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission ("the Commission") to increase its commodity charge from \$11.613/GJ to \$12.782/GJ, and to decrease Rider A from \$0.987 per gigajoule to \$0.569 per gigajoule, both effective January 1, 2003 on an interim basis; and
- B. Centra Whistler requested that the application be dealt with through the Commission's Negotiated Settlement Process; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the application for interim rates and considers that approval is in the public interest.

## **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission approves an interim rate increase of 5.96%, effective January 1, 2003, subject to refund with interest calculated at the average prime rate of the principal bank with which Centra Whistler conducts its business.
- 2. Centra Whistler is to inform all customers of the interim rates by way of a customer notice.
- 3. The regulatory process and timetable will be determined by future order of the Commission.
