WHEREAS:

- A. The Commission, by Order No. G-38-04, approved for Aquila Networks Canada (British Columbia) Ltd. ("Aquila") the Negotiated Settlement of its 2003 Annual Review and 2004 Revenue Requirements Application ("the Application"); and
- B. On May 3, 2004, Natural Resource Industries ("NRI") applied for a cost award for its participation in the proceeding; and
