ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On May 18, 2005, the Commission by Order No. G-46-05 issued its Decision on the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia's ("ICBC") application for approval of Selected Financial Allocation Functions ("FAMA-Phase 2") by way of a Negotiated Settlement; and
- B. On May 30, 2005, the British Columbia Public Interest Advocacy Centre ("BCPIAC") submitted a bill of costs on behalf of the BC Old Age Pensioners' Organization et al. ("BCOAPO") for its participation in the proceeding and Negotiated Settlement Process; and
- C. Commission staff have advised the Panel that BCPIAC/BCOAPO participated in the proceeding and contributed to the Negotiated Settlement Process; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the applications for cost awards with regard to the criteria and rates set out in Order No. G-15-04.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 118(1) of the Utilities Commission Act, the Commission awards \$7,412.31 to BCPIAC/BCOAPO for its participation in ICBC's FAMA-Phase 2 Application and Negotiated Settlement Proceeding.
