Re: Corix Multi Utility Services Inc. Flow-through Rate Adjustment at Sun Rivers effective February 1, 2007

On January 30, 2007, Corix Multi Utility Services Inc. ("Corix") filed for a rate increase for electric service to customers in the Sun Rivers Resort Community, near Kamloops, B.C. ("Sun Rivers") to reflect increases in the electric rates from its supplier, British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("BC Hydro"), effective February 1, 2007 in accordance with Commission Order No. G-68-05 ("the Filing"). Commission Order No. G-68-05 approved for Corix-Sun Rivers a flow-through rate adjustment mechanism for electricity rates that is similar to the mechanism that the Commission, by Order No. C-13-05, approved for Corix-Sonoma Pines. Commission Order No. C-13-05 approved a flow-through rate adjustment mechanism for electricity rates for Sonoma Pines to amend the electric monthly charges, delivery charges and commodity charges for Sonoma Pines in order to maintain customer rates at levels equivalent to those of BC Hydro, adjacent to Sonoma Pines, subject to the filing of the amended rates with the Commission within ten business days of the effective date of the changes to BC Hydro rates, and subject to review by the Commission in the event of a complaint by an interested party within 60 days of the effective date of the amended rates.

The Commission by Order No. G-103-06 approved a 4.65 percent interim rate increase for Sun Rivers effective September 1, 2006. By Order No. G-71-06 dated June 19, 2006, the Commission approved a 4.65 percent interim refundable rate increase for BC Hydro effective July 1, 2006. Subsequently, by Order No. G-143-06, the Commission approved for BC Hydro a permanent rate increase of 1.54 percent, effective July 1, 2006; an increase of 1.64 percent (above the April 1, 2006 rates), effective February 1, 2007; and a 2 percent Deferral Account Rate Rider, effective February 1, 2007.

The Filing includes Electric Tariff Rate Schedules for Sun Rivers with an effective date of February 1, 2007 and citation of Order No. G-68-05. Since the Filing is in accordance with the rate adjustment mechanism as set out in Commission Order No. G-68-05, no further Commission Order is required. The filed Electric Tariff Rate Schedules with an increase in rates of 1.64 percent (above the April 1, 2006 rates) and the 2 percent Deferral Account Rate Rider which are equivalent to BC Hydro, effective February 1, 2007, are accepted and included with this letter.

The Filing does not address the interim rate increase approved by Commission Order No. G-103-06 that is subject to refund with interest. Corix is to file with the Commission within 30 days of this Letter the calculated refund to customers for the difference between the 1.54 percent effective increase in rates and the interim 4.65 percent rate increase for the period from September 1, 2006 to January 31, 2007 plus interest. Corix is to refund in a timely manner to customers with interest at the average prime rate of the principal bank with which Corix conducts its business.
