## IN THE MATTER OF the Utilities Commission Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 473

An Application by CEG Energy Options Inc. for a Gas Marketer Licence

### ORDER

#### WHEREAS:

- A. On November 29, 2006 CEG Energy Options Inc. ("CEG") applied to the Commission for a Gas Marketer Licence. The application included the payment of the \$1,000 application fee and a current \$250,000 Letter of Credit pursuant to the requirements of Item 3 of the Licence application form; and
- B. The Commission has reviewed CEG's application and relying upon the information and representations made by CEG, finds that approval of the Gas Marketer Licence subject to conditions is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to Section 71.1(6) of the Utilities Commission Act the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission issues to CEG a Gas Marketer Licence for the period December 7, 2006 to October 31, 2007.
- 2. The Licence is subject to the following conditions:
  - 2.1 CEG will carry out the undertakings as set out in the application for a Licence to Market Natural Gas dated November 29, 2006 and the Rules for Gas Marketers.
  - 2.2 CEG will comply with the Code of Conduct for Gas Marketers and Gas Tariff Rate Schedule 36 of Terasen Gas Inc.
  - 2.3 CEG will maintain a Letter of Credit or acceptable substitute in full force and effect for the duration of the Licence.
  - 2.4 CEG will maintain a Working Capital position of at least \$50,000 and a Current Ratio of current assets to current liabilities of at least 1.10.
