ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. BC Hydro filed on March 15, 2007, pursuant to the Utilities Commission Act and Commission Order No. G-148-06, an Application ("Application") to update BC Hydro's rates and terms and conditions of service; and
- B. The Commission Panel has reviewed the Application and has determined that a Preliminary Regulatory Timetable should be established and a Procedural Conference held on Friday, May 4, 2007 to determine the method and timing for further review of the Application.

THE APPLICATION

On March 15, 2007 British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("BC Hydro") filed its 2007 Rate Design Application (the "Application") with the British Columbia Utilities Commission ("the Commission"). BC Hydro states that the principal focus of the Application is to ensure that it's rates and terms and conditions of service are fair, efficient and simple and defines these objectives as follows:

- **Fair** means that each customer class bears a fair share of the costs caused by that class to the extent practicable. BC Hydro is proposing to rebalance the rates of three customer classes so that the rates more closely reflect the costs caused by customers in those rates classes;
- **Efficient** means rates that provide efficient price signals at the margin, including price signals that encourage energy conservation and load management to the extent practicable. BC Hydro is proposing to restructure the rate for large general service customers and to phase out the E-Plus rates over time in order to provide better price signals to those customers; and
- **Simple** means rates and Terms and Conditions that are clear, transparent and cost-effective to implement. BC Hydro is proposing to revise its Terms and Conditions, to eliminate ten rate schedules and to simplify the calculation of the Extension Fee for new customers.

BC Hydro is also proposing to update its Standard Charges to reflect current costs.

THE REGULATORY PROCESS

The Commission will hold a Procedural Conference in Vancouver on Friday, May 4, 2007 to discuss procedural matters related to the Application.
