### ORDER

#### WHEREAS:

- A. Pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (the "Act") on February 25, 2009 British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("BC Hydro") filed with British Columbia Utilities Commission ("the Commission") an Electricity Purchase Agreement ("EPA") from the Standing Offer Program ("SOP") for the Cypress Creek Project (the "Filing"); and
- B. The Filing consisted of a confidential filing ("Attachment A") and a public filing ("Attachment B"); and
- C. BC Hydro filed Attachment A on a confidential basis because it contains information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to result in harm to the proponent's competitive position and/or prejudice BC Hydro's acquisition processes under the SOP; and
- D. The Commission acknowledges receipt of Schedule 1, which BC Hydro included in the Filing that sets out the key project-specific EPA amendments to the Standard Form SOP EPA; and
- E. BC Hydro has confirmed that the Filing is for an eligible generating facility as set out in section 64.03 of the Act; and
- F. BC Hydro provided written notice to potentially affected First Nations to advise the Application for the EPA had been filed with the Commission; and
- G. BC Hydro received no comments from potentially affected First Nations; and
- H. Prior to issuing tenures, permits and licences related to the project, provincial and federal Crown agencies consulted potentially affected First Nations with respect to impacts on aboriginal rights and title; and

- I. The Commission concludes that the Crown's duty to consult First Nations with respect to the filing of the EPA has been met; and
- J. The Commission has considered the Filing under the Standing Offer Program and has determined that it is in the public interest.

## **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission accepts for filing the Cypress Creek EPA that are set out in Appendix A and its Amendments that are set out in Appendix B to this Order as amendments to Energy Purchase Agreement, pursuant to section 71 of the Act.
- 2. The Commission will keep confidential Attachment A of the Filing.
