Re: British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority ("BC Hydro")

Transmission Service Rates

Customer Baseline Load (CBL) F2009 and F2010

On August 7, 2009, BC Hydro filed an application ("Application") seeking British Columbia Utilities Commission ("Commission") approval of:

- The CBLs and transfers to RS 1823 Energy Charge A in the columns identified as "Adjusted F2008 CBL (366 days)" contained in Appendix A of the F08/F09 CBL Application on a final and permanent basis. These are for certain F2008 CBLs that were revised during the year in accordance with the CBL Guidelines – BC Hydro Tariff Supplement No. 74.
- 2. The CBLs and transfers to RS 1823 Energy Charge A in the columns identified as "Adjusted F2009 CBL for Final Approval" contained in Appendix A of the F09/F10 CBL Application on a final and permanent basis.
- 3. The CBLs and transfers to RS 1823A in the columns identified as "Interim F2010 CBL for Interim Approval" contained in Appendix A of the F09/F10 CBL Application on an interim basis until such time as they are approved on a permanent basis by the Commission.
- 4. The new and revised CBL Adjustment Tariff Practices as proposed by BC Hydro in its F09/F10 CBL Application.

Per section 6.2.1 of Tariff Supplement No. 74 - the CBL Determination Guidelines, BC Hydro has submitted all F2010 CBL determinations, and any required adjustments to the F2009 CBLs, to the customer for review and comment prior to this filing.

BC Hydro is being requested to provide each RS 1823 customer with a copy of this letter, attached Order G-100-09, and the new and proposed CBL Adjustment Tariff Practice by September 23, 2009. By way of a copy of this letter and attachments, customers are invited to comment on the proposed CBL Adjustment Tariff Practice by October 14, 2009.

Each RS 1823 customer is requested to inform the Commission by October 14, 2009, as to whether or not it disputes its Adjusted F2009 CBL or Interim F2010 CBL as proposed by BC Hydro in the Application. In the event that any customer does not so advise the Commission by the date stipulated for it, the Commission will conclude

that the customer agrees with the CBLs proposed by BC Hydro and the proposed revisions to the CBL Adjustment Tariff practices. After receiving the responses, the Commission will determine what further process, if any, is required.
