ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On November 30, 2009 pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act* ("Act"), FortisBCInc. ("FortisBC") filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (the "Commission") an Electricity Purchase Agreement ("EPA") dated October 30, 2009 for a call option between FortisBC and Teck Metals, Ltd. ("Teck") and the EPA was made pursuant to the Western Systems Power Pool Agreement; and
- B. In the filing, FortisBC requested that the Commission keep the EPA confidential as it contains commercially sensitive information; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the EPA and has determined that the filing is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to section 71 of the Act, the EPA that is set out as Appendix A to the Filing is accepted.
- 2. The Commission will keep confidential the EPA and Appendix A of the Filing.
- 3. FortisBC will file a report, by April 10, 2010, on the monthly amounts of firm capacity/energy purchases and unit prices paid for firm capacity/energy as well as the total monthly payments to Teck.
