An Application by Teck Metals Inc. for Registration as a Responsible Entity for certain functions required for compliance with Mandatory Reliability Standards

ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. Order G-123-09 approved the Registration Manual for entities subject to adopted Mandatory Reliability Standards and required that entities subject to the standards register with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) by December 31, 2009; and
- B. The Registration Manual requires that the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) in its role as the Mandatory Reliability Standards Administrator, review and recommend registration for all applicable Entities and allows 21 days for Entities to comment to the Commission on WECC's recommendations; and
- C. On April 28, 2010, WECC recommended that the Commission approve the Teck Metals Inc. registration for the functions of Transmission Owner, Transmission Operator, Generator Owner, and Generator Operator and noted that Teck Metals Inc. disagreed with the registration for Transmission Operator; and
- D. Teck Metals notified the Commission on July 7, 2010 that they no longer disputed the WECC recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 125.2 of *the Utilities Commission Act*, the Commission approves for Teck Metals Inc. the registration for the functions of Transmission Owner, Transmission Operator, Generator Owner, and Generator Operator as recommended by WECC.
