ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. Commission Order G-29-10 approved the registration of British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) and the British Columbia Transmission Corporation (BCTC) for certain functions as responsible entities for Mandatory Reliability Standards (MRS); and
- B. On July 9, 2010, BC Hydro informed the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) of a change in circumstance whereby BC Hydro as of July 5, 2010, assumed all of BCTC's assets, properties, obligations, and liabilities, and requested that BCTC be deregistered for its MRS functions and that BC Hydro have those functions added to its responsibilities; and
- C. On July 15, 2010, WECC recommended the Commission approve BC Hydro's request.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission accepts the WECC's recommendations and approves BCTC's deregistration and BC Hydro's added functions for Transmission Operator, Balancing Authority, Planning Authority, Transmission Planner, Transmission Service Provider, Transmission Owner, and Distribution Provider.
