On February 7, 2011, Mr. Driedger, on behalf of the Coalition, filed a complaint (see attachments) with the Commission. The complaint provides arguments against the disconnection of electric service to the customers of Birds Eye Cove Power (BECP).

In response to the complaint, the Commission is considering whether it needs to suspend part of item 17 of BECP's Interim Electrical Tariff that addresses disconnection from service when customer payments are in arrears. The suspension of the portion of item 17 of BECP's Interim Electrical Tariff would remain in effect until the Commission orders otherwise.

The Commission requests BECP to respond to this complaint by Friday, February 11, 2011 and the Coalition members to reply to BECP's response by Tuesday, February 15, 2011.

Furthermore, the Commission requests that BECP not take any further action to disconnect service to its customers until the Commission has made its determination on the complaint.
