## ORDER

## **WHEREAS:**

- A. Section 125.2 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (Act) assigns exclusive jurisdiction to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) to determine whether a "reliability standard," as defined in the Act, is in the public interest and should be adopted in British Columbia;
- B. Order G-123-09 approved the Registration Manual for entities subject to adopted Mandatory Reliability Standards and required that entities subject to the standards register with the Commission;
- C. The Registration Manual requires that the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC), in its role as the Mandatory Reliability Standards Administrator, review and recommend registration for all applicable Entities and allows 21 days for Entities to file comment with the Commission on WECC's recommendations;
- D. On April 20, 2012, WECC Recommended that Howe Sound Pulp and Paper be registered for the function of Distribution Provider and Load Serving Entity, and provided Howe Sound Pulp and Paper with a letter requesting their comment;
- E. Howe Sound Pulp and Paper provided no letter of objection within the required period;
- F. The Commission considers that registration is required.
