## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) Order G-202-12 dated December 27, 2012 approved Fortis BC Inc.'s Guidelines for Establishing Entitlement to Non-PPA Embedded Cost Power and Matching Methodology (Compliance Filing to Order G-188-11);
- B. On January 7, 2013, British Columbia Pensioners' and Seniors' Association *et al.* (BCPSO) submitted a Participant Assistance/Cost Award (PACA) application for its participation in the proceeding;
- C. By letter dated February 1, 2013, Fortis BC Inc. stated it had no comment on the PACA application; and
- D. The Commission has reviewed the PACA application and comments from FortisBCInc. with regard to the criteria and rates set out in the PACA Guidelines in Commission Order G-72-07 and has concluded that a cost award should be approved for BCPSO in the amount set out in its application.

## **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to section 118(1) of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the Commission awards funds to BCPSO in the amount of \$5,252.80.
- 2. Fortis BC is directed to reimburse BCPSO for the amount that has been awarded in a timely manner.
