# IN THE MATTER OF the Utilities Commission Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 473 and

Application by Casa Del Mila Oro Geothermal for Approval of Rates, Tariff Terms and Conditions and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

### ORDER

#### **WHEREAS:**

- A. On January 16, 2014, by Order G-6-14 following a complaint and hearing, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) found the person, or the person's lessee, trustee, receiver or liquidator who owns or operates the geothermal heating and cooling facilities known as Casa Del Mila Oro (CDMO) Geothermal to be a public utility as defined by the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA);
- B. On July 9, 2014, by Order G-89-14, the Commission directed CDMO Geothermal to file its schedule of rates and terms and conditions of service with the Commission for approval as soon as possible, but no later than July 16, 2014. The filing must also include a detailed justification of how the rates and terms established by it are not unjust, unreasonable or unduly discriminatory pursuant to section 59 of the UCA;
- C. On August 18, 2014, CDMO Geothermal applied to the Commission for approval of Rates, Tariff Terms and Conditions and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (Application); and
- D. The Commission considers that establishing a preliminary Regulatory Timetable for the review of the Application is warranted.

#### **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. A preliminary Regulatory Timetable as set out in Appendix A to this Order is established.
- 2. Interveners and Interested Parties must register with the Commission, in writing or by electronic submission, by Friday, September 12, 2013. Interveners should specifically state the nature of their interest

in the Application and identify generally the nature of the issues that they may intend to pursue during the proceeding and the nature and extent of their anticipated involvement in the review process. - 3. In accordance with the Regulatory Timetable attached as Appendix A to this Order, Intervener submissions must be received by September 12, 2014, on the following issues:
  - a. process options for the review of the Application, including:
    - a written hearing; and
    - a streamlined review process, a description of this process is available on the Commission website at <a href="http://www.bcuc.com/Documents/Guidelines/2012/DOC\_30215\_03-12-Streamlined%20Review%20Process%20Guidelines.pdf">http://www.bcuc.com/Documents/Guidelines/2012/DOC\_30215\_03-12-Streamlined%20Review%20Process%20Guidelines.pdf</a>. The Commission encourages participants supporting a streamlined review process and representing similar issues to work together;
  - b. draft regulatory timetable included in Appendix A, including dates for the proposed Procedural Information Session, Streamlined Review Process;
  - c. location of the streamlined review process (Vancouver, BC or Osoyoos, BC);
  - d. interest in attending the proposed procedural information session and a streamlined review process and preferred method of participation (e.g. teleconference, webcast, or in person); and
  - e. other matters that will assist the Commission to efficiently review all aspects of the Application.
  - 4. Casa Del Mila Oro Geothermal shall post a copy of this Order in the Casa Del Mila Oro Resort.
  - 5. After receiving Intervener Submissions, the Commission will issue a further procedural order and regulatory agenda for the review of the Application.
  - 6. If Interveners support a streamlined review process for the review of the Application, the Commission proposes to hold an information session on Wednesday, September 24, 2014, to educate Interveners on how the streamlined review process works.
