ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On February 4, 2013, by Order C-1-13, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) granted approval for FortisBC Alternative Energy Services Inc. (FAES) to purchase and operate the TELUS Garden Thermal Energy System;
- B. By Order G-172-14, the Commission established the regulatory timetable for review of the Application, which included one round of information requests and responses;
- C. On December 12, 2014, the Commission received an application for Participant Assistance/Cost Award (PACA) from BC Sustainable Energy Association and the Sierra Club of BC for their participation in the Proceeding;
- D. By letter dated January 2, 2015, FAES provided its comments on the PACA application and stated that it had no comments on the amounts submitted by the intervener so long as the Commission had no concerns with the times identified or the amounts applied for; and
- E. The Commission has reviewed the PACA application in accordance with the criteria and rates set out in the PACA Guidelines to Commission Order G-72-07, and concludes that cost award should be approved.
