ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On September 15, 2014, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) issued its Decision and Order G-138-14 approving for FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) a Multi-Year Performance Based Ratemaking (PBR) Plan for 2014 through 2019 (PBR Decision);
- B. Pursuant to the PBR Decision, under the PBR Plan, FEI is to conduct an Annual Review process to set delivery rates for each year;
- C. On November 13, 2014, the Commission issued Order G-178-14 approving, among other things, FEI's 2015 Variable and Demand Delivery Rates on an interim and refundable basis, pending the outcome of the Annual Review of 2015 delivery rates;
- D. On January 14, 2015, FEI submitted an application for its Annual Review of 2015 Delivery Rates (Application); and
- E. The Commission considers establishing a regulatory timetable for the review of the Application is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to sections 59 to 61 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the British Columbia Utilities Commission orders as follows:

1. The regulatory timetable for review of the Application is set out in Appendix A to this order.

- 2. A Workshop to review FortisBC Energy Inc.'s 2014 performance results and the 2015 revenue requirements will be held on Friday, March 6, 2015 at the Commission Hearing Room on the 12th Floor, 1125 Howe Street, Vancouver, BC.
- 3. Interveners and interested parties should register their intention to intervene with the Commission via email or in writing, by Friday, January 30, 2015. Interveners and interested parties should specifically state the nature of their interest in the Application, and identify generally the nature of the issues that they intend to pursue during the proceeding, and the nature and extent of their anticipated involvement in the Application.
- 4. FortisBC Energy Inc. must post the Application and this order to its website.
