British Columbia Utilities Commission Decision and Order G-15-15
Proposed Changes to New Code of Accounts Activity View

On February 10, 2015, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) issued its decision and accompanying Order G-15-15 regarding the FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) and FortisBC Inc. (FBC) Performance Based Ratemaking Plans Application for Reconsideration and Variance. In Directive 3 of Order G-15-15, the Commission directed the following:

FEI is directed to file, for Commission approval, any proposed changes to its New Code of Accounts prior to implementing these changes. As part of the filing for approval, FEI must describe the reason for the change and provide the quantitative and qualitative impact of the change on the affected accounts. FEI must also clearly track the movement of the expenses from the old account activity to the new account activity.

On March 1, 2016, FEI filed a letter with the Commission requesting acceptance of FEI's proposed changes to its New Code of Accounts Activity View.

The Commission reviewed FEI's description of the proposed changes, including the black-lined version of the New Code of Accounts showing the changes, and accepts the changes as proposed by FEI. The Commission also acknowledges FEI's statement that it will restate all prior years' amounts, which are impacted by the proposed changes, as part of FEI's 2015 Annual Report to the Commission.
