ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On August 30, 2016, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission), pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, an executed copy of a commodity exchange agreement for the receipt and delivery of natural gas between Tenaska Marketing Canada, a Division of TMV Corp., and FEI (Agreement);
- B. On August 4, 2016, by Letter L-20-16, the Commission accepted the FEI 2016/2017 Annual Contracting Plan;
- C. FEI requests that the filing and associated documents remain confidential due to their commercially sensitive nature; and
- D. The Commission reviewed the FEI filing and is satisfied that the Agreement is consistent with the 2016/17 Annual Contracting Plan and is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act* and the British Columbia Utilities Commission's Rules for Natural Gas Energy Supply Contracts, the Commission accepts the Commodity Exchange Agreement between FortisBC Energy Inc. and Tenaska Marketing Canada, a Division of TMV Corp. The Commission will keep the filing and associated documents confidential as requested by FortisBC Energy Inc. as they contain commercially sensitive information.
