Dear Mr. Slater:

The British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) is in receipt of FortisBC Energy Inc.'s (FEI) report dated December 21, 2018 as required by Order G-141-16.

FEI filed a Gas Supply Mitigation Incentive Program (GSMIP) Year End Report for the period from November 1, 2017 to October 31, 2018 (2017-2018 GSMIP Report), in accordance with BCUC Order G-141-16 and the 2016-2019 GSMIP Term Sheet accepted by Letter L-27-16.

The 2017-2018 GSMIP Report submits the calculation of the overall GSMIP incentive payment of \$2,589,519 for the mitigation activities FEI performed in 2017/18. Appendix A of the 2017-2018 GSMIP Report contains an electronic working copy of the GSMIP model spreadsheet which FEI filed confidentially due to commercially sensitive information.

The BCUC has reviewed the 2017-2018 GSMIP Report in accordance with the 2016-2019 GSMIP Term Sheet. FEI did not perform any new activities in 2017/18. Appendix A to this letter provides a table from FEI that shows the mitigation activity summary including the overall GSMIP incentive payment of \$2,589,519 for 2017/18.

The BCUC accepts the calculation of the GSMIP incentive payment of \$2,589,519 for the mitigation activities FEI performed in the 2017/18 year. The BCUC will keep the GSMIP model spreadsheet confidential as requested by FEI as it contains commercially sensitive information.

The BCUC reviewed the 2017-2018 GSMIP Report and is satisfied that the requirements of Order G-141-16 have been met.
