ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On February 19, 2020, FortisBC Inc. (FBC) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) an application for acceptance, pursuant to sections 59-61 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) to amend Electric Tariff Rate Schedule 50 Lighting - All Areas (RS 50) to include bi-monthly billing (Application);
- B. FBC submits the proposed amended RS 50 will allow for bi-monthly billing, consistent with other FBC rate schedules which allow for either monthly or bi-monthly billing;
- C. On March 17, 2020 by Order G-55-20, the BCUC established a written comment process for the review of the Application, which included public notice, BCUC Information Requests and a deadline for letters of comment.
- D. On March 25, 2020, FBC submitted a request to amend the existing regulatory timetable, established by Order G-55-20, to extend the deadline to provide notice to all RS 50 customers of the Application to April 16, 2020; and
- E. The BCUC has reviewed the Application and considers the following determination is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE, the BCUC orders to amend the Regulatory Timetable as set out in Appendix A to this order.
