ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On September 11, 2020, CB Powerline Ltd. (CBP) filed an application to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for the Cosens Bay community electrification project (Project) pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (Application);
- B. In seeking a CPCN for the Project, CBP requests approval to build, own, operate and maintain an electrical distribution system servicing the community of Cosens Bay on Kalamalka Lake, Regional District of North Okanagan, B.C.;
- C. By Order G-248-20 dated October 5, 2020, the BCUC established a written public hearing process and a regulatory timetable for the review of the Application;
- D. By Order G-317-20 dated December 4, 2020, the BCUC amended the regulatory timetable and directed CBP to provide further notice to affected parties. The amended regulatory timetable established the deadline for intervener registration as January 7, 2021;
- E. By January 7, 2021, no intervener registration requests were received by the BCUC. By Order G-18-21 dated January 19, 2021, the BCUC amended the regulatory timetable to include dates for a second round of BCUC information requests (IR), CBP responses to BCUC IRs and CBP final argument;
- F. On February 17, 2021, the BCUC received a request for intervener registration in this proceeding from the Okanagan Indian Band (OKIB);
- G. The BCUC approved OKIB's intervener registration in this proceeding on February 18, 2021;
- H. The BCUC considers that amending the regulatory timetable for the review of this Application is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE the BCUC orders that a further regulatory timetable for the review of the Application is established, as set out in Appendix A to this order.
