ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On September 11, 2020, CB Powerline Ltd. (CBP) filed an application to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for the Cosens Bay community electrification project (Project) pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (Application);
- B. By Orders G-248-20, G-317-20, G-18-21 and G-47-21, the BCUC established and amended the regulatory timetable for the review of the Application, which includes, to date, two rounds of information requests (IRs) to CBP from the BCUC, one round of IRs to CBP from the Panel and one round of IRs to CBP from the intervener, Okanagan Indian Band (OKIB);
- C. On March 26, 2021, OKIB submitted to the BCUC a request to extend the filing deadlines under the amended regulatory timetable for submissions on further process by the parties. By Order G-101-21 dated April 1, 2021, the BCUC further amended the regulatory timetable to accommodate OKIB's extension request;
- D. On April 23, 2021, OKIB provided its submission on further process. OKIB proposes one additional round of IRs to CBP, followed by the filing of evidence by OKIB, the filing of reply evidence by CBP, and written final arguments;
- E. On April 26, 2021, CBP provided its submission on further process. CBP opposes the inclusion of an additional round of IRs and proposes the further process include the filing of evidence by OKIB, the filing of reply evidence by CBP and written final arguments;
- F. The BCUC has reviewed the submissions on further process by OKIB and CBP and determines that a further regulatory timetable for the review of the Application is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE the BCUC orders that a further regulatory timetable for the review of the Application is established, as set out in Appendix A to this order.
