### ORDER NUMBER G-260-22

IN THE MATTER OF the *Utilities Commission Act*, RSBC 1996, Chapter 473

and

British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority

#### **ORDER**

#### WHEREAS:

- A. On March 11, 2022, the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) requesting acceptance of a cost range of \$24.8 million to \$32.8 million in capital expenditures for the Energy Management System Upgrade Project (Project), pursuant to section 44.2 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) (Application);
- B. BC Hydro's Bulk Electric System (Bulk Electric System) comprises a network of generation resources, transmission lines, interconnections with neighbouring systems and associated equipment, generally operated at voltages of 100 kV or higher. The Bulk Electric System is monitored, controlled, and operated using a technology system called the Energy Management System (EMS). The current EMS software and hardware on which it runs are at end-of-life. The Project consists of upgrading the EMS software and hardware;
- C. By Order G-102-22, dated April 14, 2022, the BCUC established a regulatory timetable for review of the Application, which included public notice, intervener registration, one round of BCUC and intervener information requests (IRs), BC Hydro responses to IRs and submissions on further process. The regulatory timetable was subsequently amended by Order G-168-22 on June 20, 2022.
- D. By Order G-235-22, dated August 17, 2022, the BCUC established a further regulatory timetable including, among other things a second round of BCUC and intervener IRs;
- E. By letter dated September 14, 2022, BC Hydro requested an extension for filing responses to BCUC and Intervener IR No. 2. In the request, BC Hydro states it is seeking additional time as a high number of intervener IRs are concentrated on specialized topics requiring input from a small number of subject matter experts; and

F. The BCUC has reviewed the request and determines that an amendment to the regulatory timetable is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** the BCUC orders that the regulatory timetable is amended as set out in Appendix A to this order.
