ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On June 30, 2022, River District Energy Limited Partnership (RDE) submitted an application to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to construct and operate the second phase of the District Energy Utility System (DEU) for the River District Development (River District) (River District DEU), pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) (Application);
- B. The regulatory process for the review of the Application included a written public hearing process, consisting of two rounds of written information requests, and written final and reply arguments;
- C. The following parties registered as interveners in the proceeding:
 - British Columbia Sustainable Energy Association (BCSEA); and
 - Residential Consumer Intervener Association (RCIA).
- D. By Order C-3-23 dated June 27, 2023, the BCUC granted a CPCN for the second phase of the River District DEU;
